

**MEMORANDUM ON COOPERATION  
IN THE EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND CULTURE DOMAINS**

**BETWEEN:**

- 1- **MAGTECH SOLUTIONS (P) LTD, R-14/28, RAJ NAGAR, GHAZIABAD (UTTAR PRADESH), INDIA** represented by Mr. Subhash Jain, Director General (hereinafter referred to as First Party),
- 2- **NON-GOVERNMENTAL AUTONOMOUS NON-PROFIT HIGHER VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ORGANIZATION “INSTITUTE OF WORLD CIVILIZATIONS”**, represented by Mr. Alexander Streltsov, President (hereinafter referred to as Second Party),
- 3- **NON-COMMERCIAL PARTNERSHIP ““DISHA” RUSSIAN-INDIAN FRIENDSHIP SOCIETY”**, represented by D-r Rameshwar Singh, President (hereinafter referred to as Third Party)

**SEEKING**

Activation of cooperation in the education, science and culture domains between the Russian Federation and India,

**AIMING TO**

Create favourable conditions for the development of Russian-Indian relationships

**ACKNOWLEDGING**

The importance of government initiatives promotion as well as cooperation with non-governmental organizations in order to establish and develop mutual relationships between the Russian Federation and India

**THE PARTIES HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. To establish mutually beneficial relationship based on cooperation and development in the education, science and culture domains. The areas of cooperation and development between MAGTECH SOLUTIONS, INDIA (First Party) and INSTITUTE OF WORLD CIVILIZATIONS, RUSSIA (Second Party) include student, researchers, publications, education plans and R&D projects exchange programs.
2. First Party will contribute to the study of Indian tourism organization, Indian civilization and history of Indian culture by the Second Party (Russian students/institute) in universities, colleges, schools and institutes working in India, and, vice versa, Second Party will do the same for the First Party in Russia. Third Party will actively assist First and Second Parties in cross-cultural communications arrangement.
3. The Parties can conclude Agreements with different schools, colleges and universities in India on behalf of the Second Party and, vice versa, Second Party can do the same on behalf of the First Party in Russia. Third Party provides assistance in contact organization for the other Parties.
4. The Parties agree to cooperate in order to increase the research level in the education, culture and history domains of the both countries as follows:


The Parties will strive to encourage and stimulate contacts and cooperation in education, history, culture and tourism between the concerned universities and institutes of the two countries.

The Parties will be exchanging books, scientific publications, research works in scientific laboratories, educational programs, academic projects, programs of courses and intensive Hindi/Russian courses, materials from seminars and conferences and any other information and data of mutual interest.


The Parties encourage the development of joint research projects and preparation of joint publications as well as the organization of conferences, exhibitions and symposiums on the issues of mutual interest.

The Parties promote the organization of tours and excursions to the historical sites of India and the Russian Federation.

Under the auspices of the Parties conduct the exchange of students / research workers aimed at organizing courses and implementing research projects agreed upon by the Parties.







Promotion of studying dance and drama related to Indian folk music and folk dances as well as learning to play the Indian bagpipes in the Russian Federation.

The Parties encourage other forms of cooperation in the predefined areas, e.g. learning the language.

**MEMORANDUM IMPLEMENTATION:**

The Parties will be jointly regulating the exchange of information and experience regarding the cooperation and development in the education, culture and history domain.

Finance issues of joint activities will be solved by the Parties through additional agreements on every individual project or group of projects.

Main provisions of this Memorandum may be complemented or amended on the ground of the Parties' written consent.

**MEMORANDUM VALIDITY PERIOD**

This Memorandum comes into effect on the date of its signature.

The present Memorandum remains effective during the initial term of three (3) years

If none of the parties announces opting out of implementing the Memorandum provisions, it will be prolonged by another term of one (1) year

Cancelling the implementation of the Memorandum provisions is carried out through the written application of one the Parties submitted at least three (3) months before the Memorandum cancellation


Signed in Moscow on February 19, 2015. Each Party has two copies of the Memorandum (in Russian and English) carrying equal legal force.
